State Coal Mine, Wonthaggi

A disabled parking bay is available near the entry to the complex. Ramp entry is provided to the Centre. Most above ground buildings are accessible to wheelchair users. Access to the underground tour (temporarily closed) is limited for wheelchair users, as the entry and exit to the mine is via a skip. A disabled toilet is located at the Visitor Centre.

Warrook Cattle Farm

South Gippsland Highway, Monomeith

Disabled parking is located 300 metres from entrance. Drop off point at Gift Shop, which has an accessible entry. Wide doorways to entry and internal toilets, plus outside disabled toilet. Entry can be slippery. Entry is over level threshold and ramp, but no handrails. Limited wheelchair space in dining room.

Designated disabled car park 1 metre from front entrance. Wheelchair accessible pathways & ramp access to building. Front door is open during operating times. Wildlife viewing areas and Shop/Café area are wheelchair accessible. Disabled toilet provided. Clear signage throughout complex.

A Maze 'N Things

Phillip Island Road, Cowes

Tel: (03) 5952 2283

Disabled parking is available approximately 25 metres from the entry. Clear pathway on approach. Entrance through wide automatic doors. Café and toilets wheelchair accessible. Wheelchair access limited in maze area. Anti Gravity Room and some areas of the Illusion Rooms and Puzzle Island are not wheelchair accessible. A wheelchair is available free of charge, for visitors with limited mobility.

Bay Connections Cruises

The Kasey-Lee is wheelchair friendly. Access onto the boat is from Cowes Jetty which has 3-12 steps (depending on the tide). Cruise staff are willing to assist with access (please book ahead for this service). There is a 650 mm wide access ramp from the Jetty onto the boat. Disabled access to lower deck outside and rear of the lower deck inside is available on the boat. Disabled toilet provided.

Churchill Island

Phillip Island Tourist Road, Newhaven

Two disabled parking spaces are available 20 metres from the Visitor Centre. The Centre has level access to the entry with manual door opening outwards. A low counter top is provided for easy access to staff. A disabled toilet is available in the Visitor Centre. The Visitor Centre, gardens and Amess Homestead are wheelchair accessible. Outdoor access to the farm and homestead areas is varied with some areas being quite steep. Access into Amess Homestead for wheelchair users is available via the back verandah. A wheelchair is available free of charge, for visitors with limited mobility. Easy to read signage provided throughout.

Heritage Centre

Disabled parking is available outside the Centre in Thompson Avenue. Clear approach with entry via automatic doors. The Centre is wheelchair accessible and a disabled toilet is available.

Koala Conservation Centre

Phillip Island Tourist Road, Cowes

Four disabled parking bays are located outside the main entrance approximately 100 metres from the Centre. A level pathway leads to open doors that are wheelchair accessible. The interior of the Visitor Centre is fully wheelchair accessible. The koala viewing areas are wheelchair accessible along a series of boardwalks (gradient to 1:14). The pathways to the elevated boardwalks are compacted gravel. There is a disabled toilet in the Visitors Centre for which a key must be obtained from Reception.

Maru Fauna Park

Disabled parking is located 15 metres from main entrance along a level non-slip surface. Main entrance is accessible to wheelchairs on a slip resistant pathway. Wildlife viewing areas and Café are wheelchair accessible. Walkways and ramps have handrails. A disabled toilet is provided.

National Vietnam Museum

Parking is available at the front of the Museum on the main road (approx 3 metres from entry). Entry is level, with a wheelchair accessible doorway and a manual door opening inwards. Easy access toilet but no handrails.

The Nobbies Centre

Point Grant, Ventnor

Disabled parking is available close to the main entrance. The centre is fully accessible by a series of ramps.

Phillip Island Vineyard & Winery

Parking is available next to the winery. Slight incline up crushed gravel driveway to the entry. Manual doors at the entrance open outwards. Wine tasting available in sunroom. Easy access toilet available, but no handrails.

Penguin Parade

Nobbies Road, Ventnor

Six disabled parking bays are located in the car park (Area 1) adjacent to the Visitor Centre, approximately 60 metres from the entrance. The entry pathway is fully lit and has slip resistant pavers. Ramp access is available. Wide manual doors for wheelchair access are left open during summer and at penguin parade viewing time. A disabled toilet is available in Visitor Centre. All displays are visible from wheelchair height. Wheelchairs are available free of charge, for visitors with limited mobility. A motorised buggy is available upon request from Visitor Centre to the viewing area. Ramps to viewing platforms have handrails with standing and seating areas.

Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit Visitor Centre

Disabled parking is located 15 metres from the entry. Access to the main entry is on a level ground of gravel, concrete and brick paving, with automatic doors. The History of Motorsport display is accessible for wheelchair users. The self guided tour and Café (entry via the garden area) is accessible with assistance. The guided tour of the circuit is not wheelchair accessible. A disabled toilet is at the Visitor Centre.

Phillip Island Tenpin Bowling & Entertainment Centre

Parking is available approx. 14 metres from the Centre. Concrete level pathway leads to entry. Double front doors can be opened during operating hours. Tenpin bowling is available for persons with a disability, with assistance from staff and carers as required. A disabled toilet is available.

Parking is available next to the Centre. Slight incline into the Visitor Centre. Entry doors open outwards for wheelchair access. Wildlife viewing areas have ramps and handrails. A disabled toilet is available.
