Phillip Island	Phillip Island Nature Park Penguin Parade 	Discover all about the lives of Little Penguins at the Penguin Parade Visitor Centre, which features a theatre and interactive displays. Relax in the café that offers meals and delicious snacks. Enjoy shopping in the unique Penguin Shop and Spirit of the Island store. Take home a memory of your visit with an interactive photo. There are many ways to experience the penguins: Penguin Parade, Penguins Plus Viewing Platform, Ranger Guided Tours or the Penguin Sky Box.
Phillip Island	Phillip Island Nature Park Koala Conservation Centre 	Stroll along treetop boardwalks and experience koalas in their natural habitat. Wander through bushland and enjoy the abundant birdlife. This centre is dedicated to koala research and conservation. Learn about the fascinating lives of koalas in the Visitor Centre. Enjoy a snack and purchase a unique gift. Daily Ranger Guided Tours take you behind the scenes to learn more about koala conservation
Phillip Island	Phillip Island Nature Park Churchill Island 	Step back in time to this historic island farm. Churchill Island features heritage buildings and gardens, walking tracks and much more. The Visitor Centre provides information on the island's fascinating history. Churchill Island Café & Restaurant features spectacular bay views and delicious home cooked meals from island produce. Meet the farm animals, Clydesdale horses, Highland cattle, sheep, ducks, chickens and peacocks. Daily Ranger Guided Tours of the island.
Phillip Island	Phillip Island Nature Park Nobbies Centre 	The Nobbies Centre is Australia's newest marine attraction. Explore and discover the secrets of the incredible southern marine environment including seals, sharks and dolphins via interactive displays and cameras that allow you to zoom in and out on these marine creatures. This area offers spectacular coastal scenery, viewing of the offshore seal colony at Seal Rocks and the chance to walk amongst nesting seabird colonies. It is a truly amazing natural experience!
Phillip Island	Seal Watching Cruises 	Experience this spectacular two hour cruise witnessing one of Australia's largest wild Fur Seal colonies situated on Seal Rocks lying 2kms off the rugged south west coast of Phillip Island. The boat drifts within metres of thousands of seals enabling you to witness their natural environment first hand. It is impossible not to be captivated by these naturally playful and inquisitive animals who regularly approach the boat for a closer look at you! Along the way you'll be captivated by the beautiful coastline and learning the history of Phillip Island's shoreline.
San Remo	Fishing Charters 	Boat fishing in Western Port is also a popular past time and charter fishing expeditions run out of Cowes, Newhaven, San Remo and Rhyll. Hire boats are also available from Rhyll and Cowes.

Inverloch	<p>Kite Surfing</p> 	<p>Inverloch has one of the safest and cleanest beaches in Victoria for kitesurfing. Located on a tidal inlet it offers shallow water and many easy-to-get-to beaches and sandbars which are ideal for beginners and advanced kitesurfers alike.</p> <p>If you are not sure if kiting is for you, you can have an introductory kitesurfing lesson to learn the basic skills. A stunt kite is available to introduce you to kite flying on the land.</p>
Phillip Island	<p>Bike Hire</p> 	<p>Tours & Group Rides can be organized rides for a minimum of 8 people. The ride can be tailored to skill level, purpose of the ride (i.e. educational for school children, scenic routes for tourist groups, challenging rides for experienced riders). All equipment is provided. Please book in advance at holiday times.</p>
Newhaven	<p>P I Helicopters</p> 	<p>We operate our scenic flights from Phillip Island Airport. We have 5 standard flights around the island, all with unprecedented views of our spectacular scenery, or we can tailor a flight to suit your needs. We also provide joy flight services for major or fund-raising events.</p>
Cowes	<p>Phillip Island GP Circuit Hot Laps</p> 	<p>Buckle in for the real deal; an adrenalin-amping triple lap lightning ride around the Phillip Island circuit with an experienced racing driver in HSV Hot Laps. The smooth curves and super fast straight of this world class circuit are strung along some of the most breathtaking coastline on the Island with rolling hills, rugged cliffs and ocean to the horizon. 3 Hot Laps in a high performance HSV V8 around this world famous circuit is sure to get your attention! Circuit tours are also available.</p>
Cowes	<p>Phillip Island GP Circuit Go Karts</p> 	<p>Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit Go Kart Track is over 720m long and in some places over 8m wide and is a scale replica of the world famous Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit. This is your chance to get the feeling that so many past and present champions have had the privilege of experiencing. Corporate functions and activity days are also available and are the perfect way to finish off a sales meeting or for a team building day. Circuit tours are also available.</p>
Cowes	<p>A Maze'N Things</p> 	<p>You will be absolutely amazed by what you can see. Water, balls and chairs go uphill, people fly in mirrors, some lose their heads and others shrink right before your very eyes. The maze itself, Australia's largest, takes an average of 45 minutes to complete. If you do eventually get out of the maze you can browse for ages in Victoria's most unique puzzle and games shop, or alternatively tackle the stimulating 19 hole maxi mini-golf course. This park has a unique appeal to a wide range of ages. All patrons are bemused, bewildered and baffled by the seemingly endless array of intriguing activities.</p>
Cowes	<p>Fun Shed</p> 	<p>The Fun Shed is still plenty of fun no matter the we it is always fun for children. Parents are able to relax and enjoy a cuppa or a light meal while the children entertain themselves on the great equipment. We have an inflated slide, jumping castle, 3 level playground complete with a flying fox, multiple slides and ball pits. There is also a basketball area, air hockey, soccer table, cubby house and junior play area and lots, lots more.</p>

Cowes	<p>10 Pin Bowling</p> 	<p>The Centre includes: Pool Tables, Air Hockey tables, Lounge, Cafe & Fully Licensed Bar, Slot Car Racing, X-Box live, Table Tennis, Internet Access, Interactive Games, E ball Games & Austar Entertainment on a large screen.</p> <p>Enjoy the thrill of bowling as well as the rest of the fun at this family friendly, air conditioned Entertainment Centre. Plenty of parking is available and there is easy access in to the centre.</p>
Cowes	<p>Grumpy's</p> 	<p>Grumpy's Amusements feature an undercover, 18-hole mini-golf course and a waterslide which is open from November to Easter, weather permitting.</p>
Cowes	<p>Golf</p> 	<p>Phillip Island Golf Course is split into two "nines". The outward nine holes are somewhat shorter, with many fine old eucalypts and an abundance of wildlife spread over the undulating and sandy ground. The front nine can lull a player into a false sense of security with its traditional and enjoyable layout.</p> <p>The course is eminently suitable for players of all ages and skill levels. It is a picturesque, challenging and extremely enjoyable course.</p>
Wonthaggi	<p>Golf</p> 	<p>Established in 1925, the Wonthaggi Golf Club boasts a picturesque 18 hole course. Set on 103 acres of undulating land, the course is a well-treed and testing 18 hole layout stretching 5757 metres with a par of 72 and an A.C.R. of 70.</p>
San Remo	<p>Golf</p> 	<p>Bass Coast Golf Course: Graham Marsh designed, world class links course; 9 holes opening late 2007, 18 holes open early 2008.</p>
Inverloch	<p>Golf</p> 	<p>Melaleuca Links is a 9 hole par 3 course with most holes around 60-70m except for the 8th which is maybe 100m. The turf is in unbelievably good condition. It's in the same class as the Melbourne sand belt. The greens are quick and true and there's even a nice undulating practice putting green.</p>
Grantville	<p>Maru Koala & Fauna Park</p> 	<p>You can experience 'up close and personal' contact with the animals: hand feed kangaroos, wallabies, emus, birds and observe koalas from the comfort of the restaurant. You can also putt your way around Aust. Swings! - 18 holes from the beach to the outback zone.</p>
Phillip Island	<p>Wildlife Park</p> 	<p>Phillip Island Wildlife Park is the largest privately-owned wildlife park in Victoria. It is an open-access park which incorporates 6.5 ha of wetland. There are over 100 animals in all, and a nocturnal animals centre.</p>
San Remo	<p>Pelican Feeding</p> 	<p>Pelican feeding takes place on the San Remo foreshore, near the jetty, each day at 11.30 a.m. San Remo is a significant ocean and bay fishing port and the San Remo Fisherman's Cooperative the leading supplier of fresh fish for the region. Holidaymakers can enjoy ocean fishing and boat charters that leave from the jetty.</p>
Rhyll	<p>Rhyll Fishing Park</p> 	<p>Come and experience lake fishing, indoor fishing in the spectacular rainforest pool, or simply enjoy the fresh locally harvested trout and yabbies. Rhyll Fishing Park offers you the chance to catch and cook your own trout.</p>

Wonthaggi	<p>State Coal Mine</p> 	<p>A visit to the State Coal Mine at Wonthaggi is a journey back to the difficult working conditions of mining days past. Preserved by Parks Victoria for future generations, this original mine site gives visitors an understanding of the life of a miner seventy years ago.</p>
Newhaven	<p>Vietnam Veterans Museum</p> 	<p>The VVAA Museum currently has over 5000 artefacts, memorabilia and photographic material which are displayed either under glass or in walk-through areas which allow the visitor to fully appreciate what it was actually like to be “in country” and absorb the era which was Vietnam. The indoor display features mannequins, photographs, scale models and dioramas, military equipment and much more.</p>
Bass Coast	<p>Coastal walks and rail trails</p> 	<p>Explore Bass Coast on foot or by bike. Take an easy stroll or tackle a challenging coastal track – there are walks and bicycle rides to suit every fitness level. Trails follow sandy tracks that wind along rugged cliff tops overlooking magnificent views of Phillip Island and the ocean and along the cliffs from San Remo towards Kilcunda, with detours leading to small deserted beaches accessible only by foot or boat. The rail trail is the only coastal rail trail in Victoria. The landscape varies from the rugged coastline at Kilcunda, to flat farmland and coastal bushland.</p>
Bass Coast	<p>Art Tour</p> 	<p>Celebrate the wealth and diversity of our arts community by visiting artists in their studios and viewing their works. The ArtTour is a self drive tour of more than 25 artists' studios in Bass Coast. Works range from landscapes and portraits to glassware and fabrics.</p>
Bass Coast Wineries & Vineyards	<p>Wine Tastings</p> <p>Phillip Island Vineyard Purple Hen Bass River Winery Ramsay's Vin Rose The Gurdies Winery Bass Valley Estate Paradise Enough Kongwak Hills Winery Nyora Vineyard & Winery</p> 	<p>The wine trail takes you to Cellar Doors in Victoria's southern-most wine region, spread through Bass Coast. You'll find small, family owned vineyards and wineries, scattered throughout picturesque rolling hills and along spectacular coastlines. You will find wines here that will lead you to ponder the individual vineyard sites and seasonal differences between vintages. You will be introduced to wines, winemakers and wineries with real character. You may find us tending the vines, checking on the wine barrels, filling bottles or sticking on labels and always ready to pour you a wine. French Island		<p>French Island National Park is a true paradise. Accessible only by 30 minute passenger ferry ride, French Island is a haven of peace and serenity. The 11,100ha park contains environments ranging from mangrove salt marsh areas to open woodlands and plays home to an equally diverse range of wildlife.</p>
