### **Wonthaggi:**

- Wonthaggi State Coal Mine – Garden St

### **Inverloch:**

## **Historic Attractions:**

### **Wonthaggi:**

- Mine whistle at noon each day (on poppet head next to Safeway)
- Old Rescue Station No. 5 Brace & entrance to McBride tunnel, Graham Street

- Monument to remember the mine explosion 1937 (13 men killed), Melbourne side of Bass Highway
- Museum in the old railway station (next to Safeway) Wonthaggi – only open Saturday.
- Paintings and entrance display to the Wonthaggi Workmen's Club (Mine History)
- Whale jawbone, entrance to the Hotel in McBride Avenue.
- Murals above Sports Store (Graham Street Roundabout).

### **Kilcunda:**

- Old Rail Trestle Bridge

## **Recreation:**

- Heated swimming pool, Recreation Reserve & Leisure Centre
- Picnic area at Guide Park, (opposite Hospital)
