

BUSSELTON TO PEMBERTON

Distance: approx 316km

The drive to Pemberton takes you along Vasse Highway passing through the majestic Karri Forrest region. The return drive brings you back along the South Western Highway.

- Busselton to Nannup - with many beautiful gardens to look at, several open all year round, Nannup is the perfect place to take some memorable photo's.

- Nannup to Pemberton - passing through the small town of Donnelly River, through the ancient Karri Forests and the Valley of the Giants, finally emerging at the picture-perfect timber town of Pemberton.

Nestled between three national parks, Pemberton has plenty to keep you busy and, with an abundance of quality accommodation available, is well worth a day or two stop-over. Climb the Gloucester Tree, enjoy local wineries, fish for trout or enjoy a feast of locally caught Marron. You can take a 4WD tour to the spectacular desert-like Yeagerup Dunes and discover a resplendent display of springtime wildflowers.

Accommodation and tours can be booked through Busselton or Dunsborough Visitor Centres.

- Pemberton to Manjimup – Don't forget to visit the timber museum.

- Manjimup to Bridgetown - full of historic old buildings, and classic Australian pubs.

- Bridgetown to Balingup - this quaint country town is surrounded by majestic jarrah trees.

- Balingup to Mullalyup – home to galleries featuring a variety of artists from the region.

- Mullalyup to Donnybrook – an area famous for its fruit. Stop in at one of the many orchards along the way and sample their produce.

- Donnybrook to Busselton – Visit the rapidly developing town of Capel, taste the local wines and explore the local arts & crafts gallery.
