Olive groves are a significant feature of the region, producing extra virgin olive oils, marinated olives and tapenades. Not to be missed are locally bred venison and marron. There is no shortage of sweet treats including fudge, chocolate, nuts, candy and ice-cream in every flavour imaginable. For tea and coffee gourmands, there are several coffee roasting and tea houses in the region specialising in creating the perfect cup. Indulge in a sweet treat for your morning or afternoon tea and watch the world go by.

Farmers' markets run most weekends throughout the year and offer a great opportunity to mingle with the locals and purchase the best in locally grown, seasonal produce as well as chutneys, preserves, honey and dressings.
