Parking

Eating

We have a refreshment kiosk on site selling hot and cold drinks, ice creams and cookies. We can arrange a morning/afternoon tea or light lunch should your group wish to eat whilst at the event. However, if your group is looking for somewhere to eat a substantial meal whilst in Frankston, we can suggest:

Daveys Bar & Restaurant (03) 9783 7255 – Cnr Nepean Hwy and Davey St, Frankston, right next to the event. Indoor and outdoor eating. Seniors meals on offer.

Sofias - (03) 9781 3303 – At the Frankston Pier, so right next to the event. Indoor and outdoor eating, Italian menu, huge meals, very reasonably priced, so excellent value. And fabulous gelati!

Waves on the Beach (03) 9770 0000 – Cnr Wells & Gould Sts, Frankston. As the name suggests, this restaurant is right on the beach. About a 5 minute walk from the event.

Frankston RSL (03) 9783 2288 – Cranbourne Rd, Frankston. About 5 minutes by bus from the event. Traditional RSL - fantastic food at great prices.

Other Activities

Should your group want something else to do while in Frankston, the Visitor Information Centre is next to our site. When you book your group into the Sand Sculpting, we can also arrange a 15 minute guided tour of the Waterfront, finishing with souvenir shopping.
