REPORTING LITTERERS

Litter can be almost any material that is disposed of incorrectly.

It includes cigarette butts, drink bottles or fast food wrappers thrown out of the car window, a load that hasn't been secured properly, or grass clippings swept into the gutter. Any litter disposed of inappropriately is illegal under the *Litter Act 1979*.

You can help reduce litter by becoming a Keep Australia Beautiful registered Litter Reporter and reporting offences to Keep Australia Beautiful via our litter report line, report card system or by logging onto our website www.kabc.wa.gov.au

Contact the Keep Australia Beautiful Council (KABC) litter report line to become a registered litter reporter or fill in the registration form included in this brochure. Once you have been appointed as a reporter, a kit will be forwarded to you which will include self-addressed litter report cards.

take action

If you see someone throwing litter from a car, take note of the:

- vehicle registration;
- make and model of the vehicle
- time and place that the offence was committed; and
- provide a description of the litter that was dropped.

The completed card can be mailed to the KABC office without stamp or envelope. The information you provide will normally result in the issue of an infringement notice to the offender. You may, on rare occasions, be required to attend a Magistrate's court to provide evidence should the offence be disputed.
