

## Suggested Trails:

- **Explore Wine Country** - This route takes you to through some picturesque country side on your journey to Broke (25km) via the Putty Road. Once in Broke the boutique vineyards, antique shop and café facilities should keep you entertained for the afternoon. Leaving Broke via Broke Road and turning left into Hermitage Road you will pass numerous vineyards, guest houses and restaurants. (25km) Turn left on the New England Highway to return to Singleton. (15km)
- **Historical Town Cycle** - This route highlights all the significant points of interest in Singleton itself. These points are marked on the map inside this brochure.
- **Leisurely Lake Ride** - For a scenic country ride why not venture along Bridgman Road for 30km to our beautiful Lake St Clair, stop for a picnic lunch and return or venture further into Mt Royal National Park to view some World Heritage Listed views! (Mountain Bikes would be required)
- **Town Head Park Cycle Safety Track** - Located on the New England Highway Town head Park supports a miniature road system designed for training young cyclists in a safe environment. The park also has picnic, BBQ, playground, toilet and parking facilities.
- **Cycleways** - The inside of this brochure displays all the local cycle routes

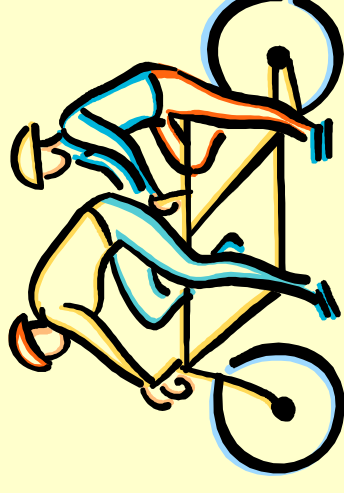
