These days, the story of Ned Kelly and the times in which he lived are preserved in an array of wonderful attractions, museums and historic walks located around the town. The town also offers accommodation in a variety of styles, fresh local fruit and wineries that have built a fine reputation for their deep and complex red, white and fortified wines
